Please read through the information found in *Saint Timothy Tidings*.

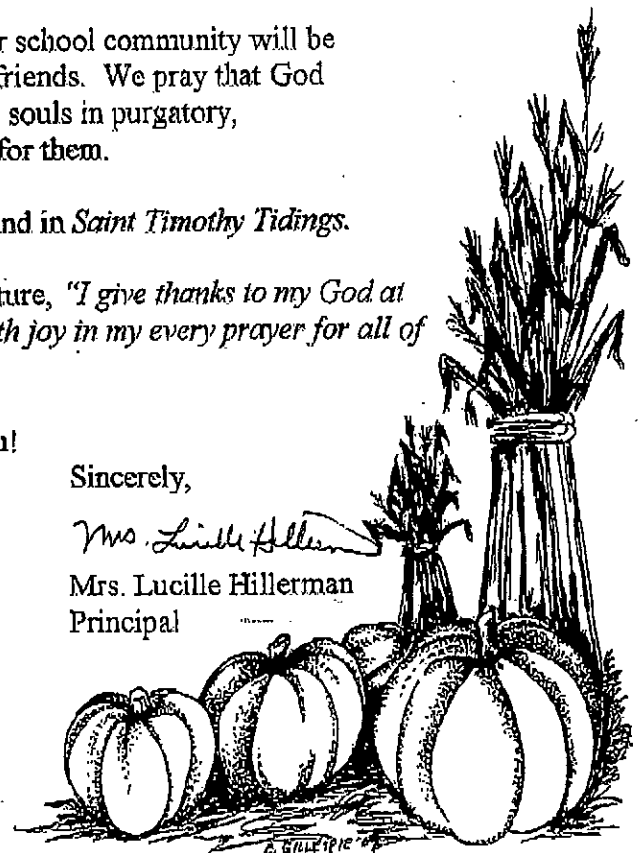
I end this letter with a quote from Sacred Scripture, "I give thanks to my God at every remembrance of you, praying always with joy in my every prayer for all of you..."
